The rebuilding of Taraz begins by drawing on memories, codifying knowledge and seeking outside help. Twenty thousand warring Mongolian Xanamen nomads are camped in tents on the steppe. They recently laid waste to the city of Kokand, a rival regional power. The leader ails and his successor is likely to be the brutal, psychotic Vandem, whose teenage daughter Borjina craves power and wealth. From Crimea, the Indigo Riders, emissaries of progressive King Lothar of Theodoro set out for the steppe to collect intelligence about the threat posed by the horde. Dmitry leads the Riders, his wife Lorenza is enigmatic and she is the heroine of the story, driven by her quest to find her missing daughter. Theodoro is beset by the Genoese and Ottomans from the south. The Indigo Riders lead a precarious existence. After Gurish is assassinated, the Genoese ally with the Jagiellon dynasty, a Lithuanian-Polish alliance, in order to dominate the trade routes. They raise the Army of the Shattering Hand to challenge the Xanamen horde. A major battle takes place on the banks of the river Don commencing with a contest of champions.
